

The Group projects for History and Geography that substitutes the exam is done in school.

Poster activity as follows:

1. Break each class and section into teams of 3 students each and the break up of teams for these two subjects should not be the same - History teacher to do one set of break up and Geography teacher to do another group.
2. Team will select a topic through lottery system from a hat from their syllabus (one for History and one for Geography)
3. Students will start to do their research independently on IT classes from 23rd to 27th April (one week). They will collect all the information and pictures according to their project topics. They are allowed to draw and color the pictures as well.
4. All these pictures and information will be sent to their mailing address and they will take the printout from their home. (Students are not allowed to bring pen drive).
5. 30th April is the deadline to submit the information and pictures through the envelop to their respected teachers.(They must write their name, ID no and topic name in the envelop.
6. They must come up with a poster. Students will start to do the project from 2nd May to 8th May in a group.

Leadership in the team - who takes major leadership role in the team? Makes decisions, takes responsibility, listens to others etc **(5%)**
